Leigh Hunt

We are delighted to be featuring the work of Cambridge artist, Leigh Hunt, in our first exhibition of 2007. We will be showing an extensive collection of his paintings spanning over sixty years. Many depict local Cambridgeshire land and river scenes and flowers in all shapes, sizes and colour.

Leigh spent his formative years in New Zealand, returning to England in 1943 to serve in the Royal Navy. In 1946 he was free to take up art studies at Kingston and The Slade in London. He then worked in advertising before becoming the Art Director of an agency. In 1983 he moved to Norfolk to paint full time. He has exhibited his work in Ely, Lavenham and London. Leigh is still painting, now from his studio in Cambridge.

Leigh is a spontaneous and very talented oil painter, whose landscape and still life paintings have tremendous movement, passion and an inspired eye for dramatic colour, light and ambience.

Modern British Masters
11th May to 9th June

This exhibition will feature some of Britain's most famous Masters in art and printmaking - Royal Academicians **Sir Peter Blake**, **Donald Hamilton Fraser**, **Sir Terry Frost** and **Sandra Blow**.

We will be showing a wonderfully exciting collection of individual prints, many hand finished by the artists themselves. Influences from the British Pop Art Movement and the British Abstract Movement combine to give a unique quality and style to each of the artists' work.

Other very well respected names that will be featured in the show include **Molly Parkin**, who exhibits at the Tate and has a permanent display at the Royal Pavilion in Brighton, **Bruce McLean**, **Chloe Cheese**, **Brendan Neiland** and local artist **Charlotte Cornish**.

The Exhibition promises to be inspiring and distinctive.

**Summer Exhibition
15th June to 31st July**

This will be an exhibition of Summer Colour by four local artists with work by **Nicola Collard, Gail de Cordova, Darryl Nantais** and **Sue Walker**.

Nicola's work features figures and flowers, incorporating embroidery and mixed media to give an original and dramatic effect.

Gail's block canvases of colour are decorated with collage and mixed media, which achieve intensity and movement.

Darryl's series of Fenland landscapes bring a contemporary feel to his traditional oil paintings, with looser brush strokes and big dramatic skies.

Sue's paintings portray mood and colour; she includes in her work the complex rhythms, textures and colour harmonies of nature working in acrylics and mixed media.

Our Summer Exhibition promises to be an exciting mixture of styles, textures and impressions.
